The Chowder Festival has two "friendly competitions" culminating in awards at the end of the event. The People's Choice Awards are decided by the votes of the attendees for "Best Of" in all the food categories and for Best Booth Presentation. We are increasing the size and visibility of the

voting tent to make it easier for all our patrons to cast their ballots.

The Judge's Choice Awards will be decided by a blind taste test conducted by a panel of 3 area "foodies". NEW this year, for our 10th Anniversary event, Sea Watch International will sponsor the prizes. Because of their support, we are able to increase cash prizes for the First place winners in the Judge's Blind Taste Test competition. The winner in the Clam Chowder category will receive a \$1000 cash prize and the winners in the Seafood Chowder and Stuffed Quahog categories will each receive \$500.
