Drop-Off

NEW! Temporary Drop-off Recycling Locations for Styrofoam Blocks and Single Stream Recycling

- Who:** New Bedford residents only. Proof of residency required.
- When:** Saturday, December 27, 2014 & Saturday, January 3, 2015, 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Where:**
1. East Rodney French Blvd. beach lot, between Hudson Street & Seymour Street
 2. Shawmut Avenue Transfer Station, 1103 Shawmut Avenue
 3. Brooklawn Park, near Pony League Field, enter at Irvington Street
- What:** Residents can drop off the following:
- Styrofoam blocks
 - Single stream recycling - e.g. bottles, cans, jugs, jars, cartons, paper, cardboard

Curbside Christmas Tree Collection

Christmas trees will be collected curbside during the week of Monday, January 12, 2015, through Friday, January 16, 2015. All trees should be placed curbside on the day after trash and recycling collection. Friday route will be collected on 1/12/15. This is the only week for curbside pickup of Christmas trees.

When preparing your tree, please follow these guidelines:

NO Tinsel

Christmas Tree Drop-Off Locations

Starting December 26th, residents can drop off Christmas trees at the following locations:

1. East Rodney French Blvd. beach parking lot, between Hudson Street & Seymour Street
2. Shawmut Avenue Transfer Station, 1103 Shawmut Avenue (M-F, 7:30-3:30 pm, Sat, 7:30-3 pm)
3. Brooklawn Park, near Pony League Field, enter at Irvington Street

Please remove all ornaments, stands, lights, tinsel, and bags.

Recycling Strings of Christmas Lights

Strings of Christmas lights can be recycled at the Shawmut Avenue Transfer Station, 1103 Shawmut Avenue. Place them in the scrap metal container. Call (508) 979-1520 for hours.

Do not place strings of lights in your recycling cart. Another option is to recycle them at Lowe's in Dartmouth.
