Job Description:

We are currently seeking a full time **Master's level clinician**. This dynamic, dedicated and motivated individual will provide office-based, individual, group and family therapy to children and families who have experienced trauma, including children who have: experienced sexual abuse, physical abuse and/or neglect; witnessed domestic or community violence; or lost a loved one due to homicide. The Master's Level Clinician will receive weekly individual supervision and support by an LICSW Supervisor. Additionally, Clinicians will be trained in evidence-based models of trauma informed practice. **Apply HERE**

- Master's degree in Social Work, Mental Health Counseling or related field required. Must be license eligible (LMHC, LCSW, or LICSW)
- Clinical experience with children required.
- Expertise in the provision of evidence-based treatments for trauma preferred.
- Strong written and communication skills.
- Bilingual/Bicultural (Spanish or Portuguese) preferred
