

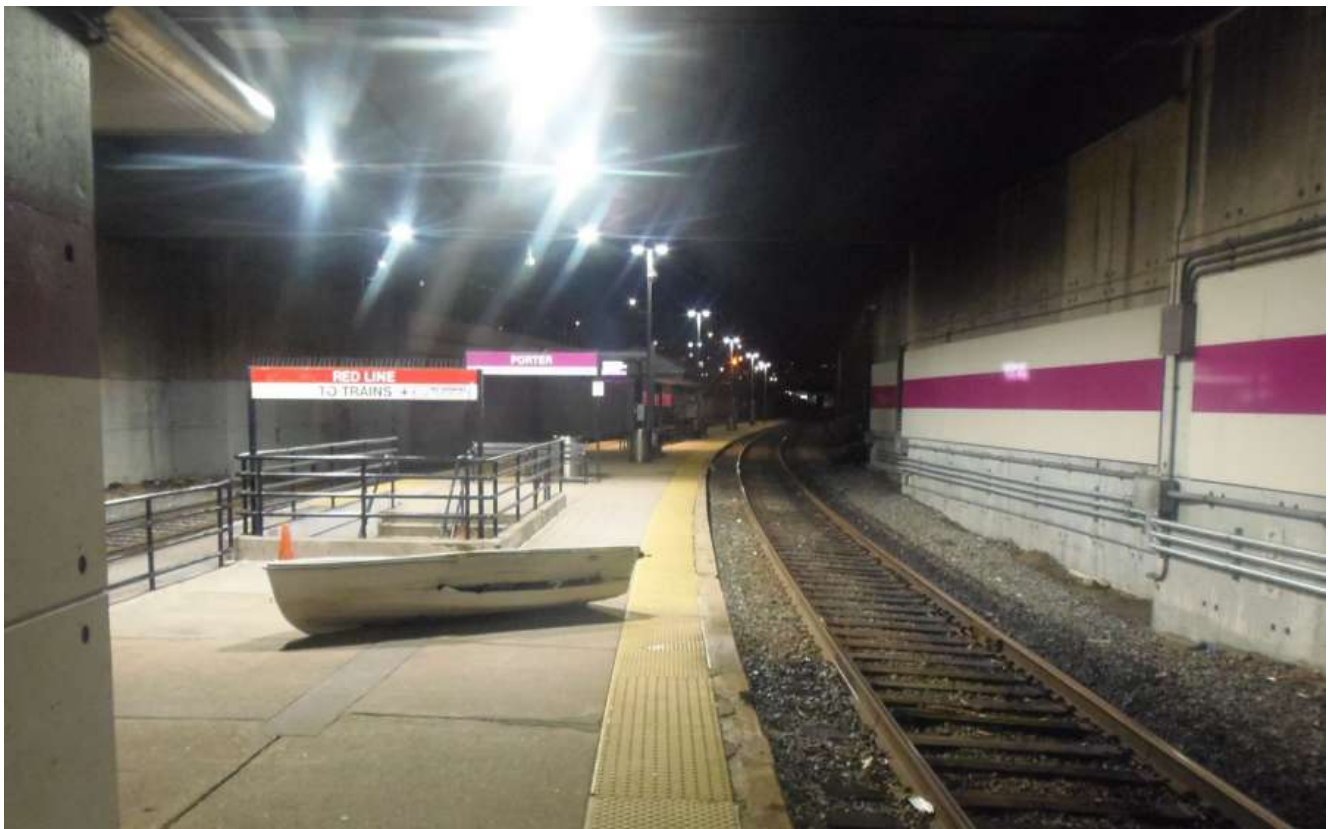
Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority Commuter Rail Train strikes...a boat
