

Massachusetts State Police add Worcester man to “Most Wanted” fugitives list after shooting man to death

“The Massachusetts State Police today added JEFFERY A. BELTRE-ROJAS, a suspect wanted in a Worcester homicide, to our list of Most Wanted fugitives. BELTRE-ROJAS is wanted for the July 9, 2020 shooting of Luis Tiro-Romero inside a residence at 6 Mount Pleasant St. Tiro-Romero died as a result of injuries from the shooting in early 2021.

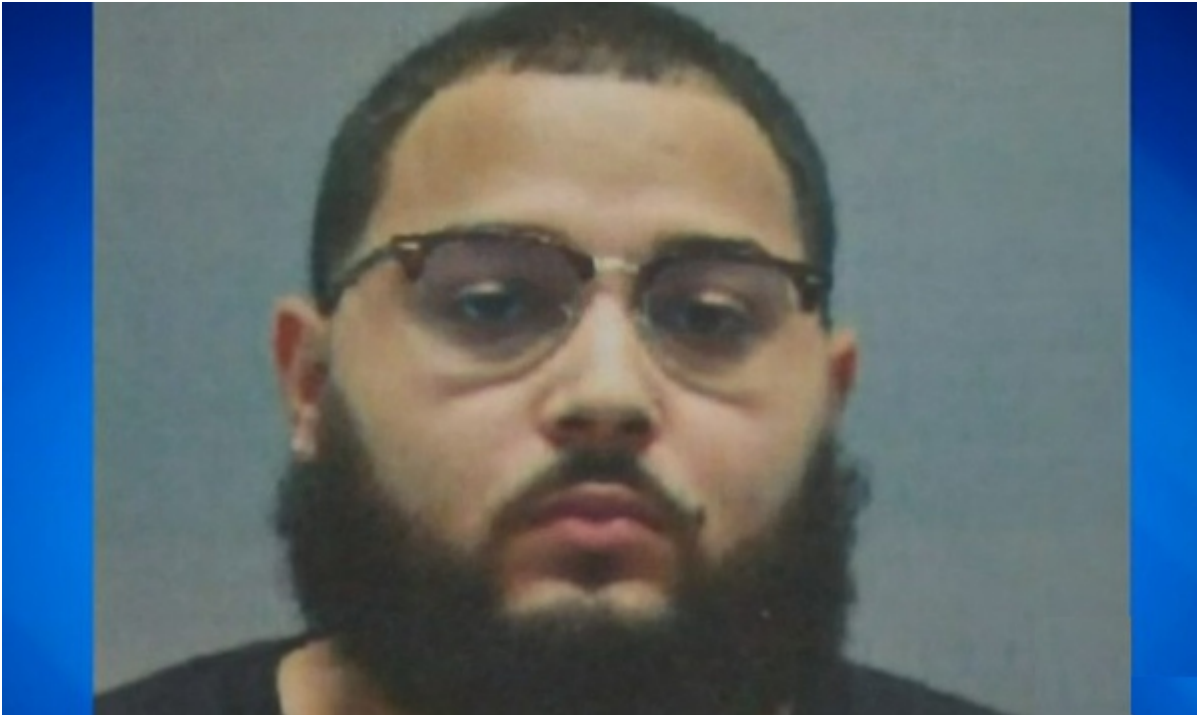
BELTRE-ROJAS, 27, is 5’7” tall, about 250 lbs., with black hair and brown eyes. He has a mole on his left cheek and multiple tattoos on his neck and arms, including the image of a pair of lips on the left side of his neck. He is believed to be actively avoiding apprehension and should be considered armed and dangerous.

Late in the afternoon of July 9, 2020, Worcester Police Officers responding to the shooting at 6 Mount Pleasant St. located Tiro-Romero in a hallway. He had been shot multiple times and was transported to a hospital in critical condition. He died in January 2021 from injuries sustained in the shooting.

The investigation by Worcester Police detectives identified BELTRE-ROJAS as a suspect, and a warrant charging him – initially – with armed assault with intent to murder and related crimes was obtained. Officers began searching for BELTRE-ROJAS. After the victim’s death, the charges against BELTRE-ROJAS were upgraded to murder. Two co-defendants are already in custody.

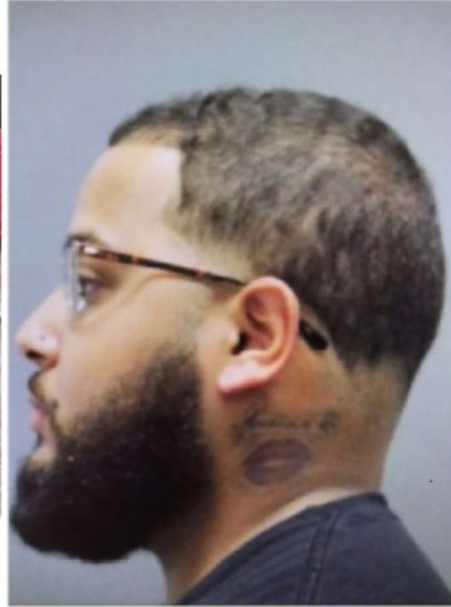

On July 9, 2020, at approximately 4:30PM, the Worcester Police Department responded to a shooting at 6 Mount Pleasant Street. Responding officers discovered a male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds who was transported to the hospital in critical condition. Subsequent investigation by Worcester PD Detectives resulted in a warrant being issued for Jeffery BELTRE-ROJAS for Armed Assault to Murder and Attempted A&B With Firearm with continental United States extradition authorized (2062CR002841). The victim later died from his injuries and BELTRE-ROJAS' charges were upgraded to Murder (2162CR000420). BELTRE-ROJAS has three additional arrest warrants issued out of Worcester Superior Court (2085CR00124), Worcester District Court (1762CR005373) and Westborough District Court (1967CR001364) for charges to include Carry Loaded Firearm, Discharge Firearm Within 500' of Building, Firearm Use in a Felony and Possess Class A Drug. BELTRE-ROJAS has a visible mole on his face, multiple tattoos on his neck and arms, is actively avoiding apprehension and should be considered Armed and Dangerous.
