

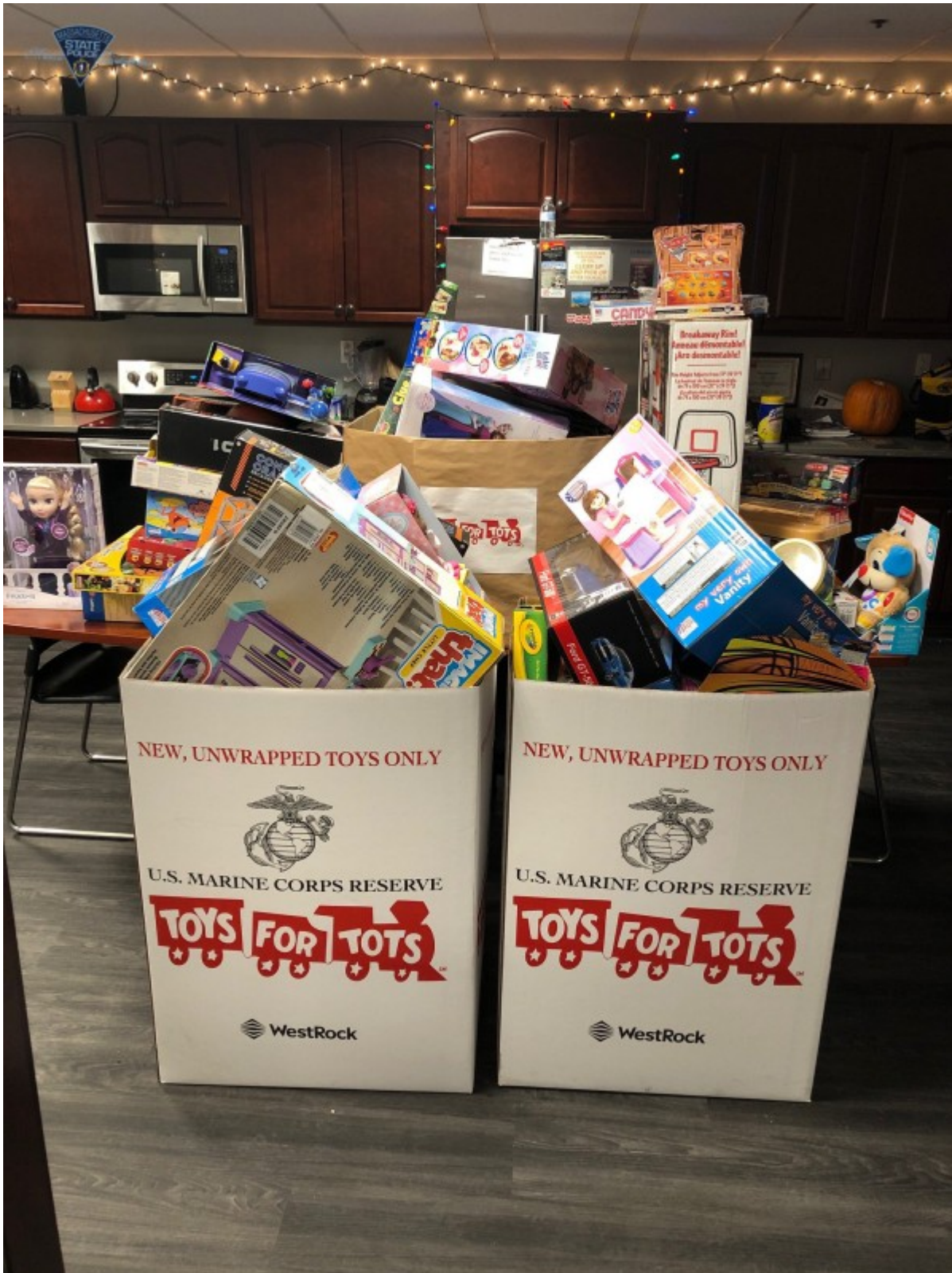
# Massachusetts State Police deliver more gifts for the Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots toy drive
