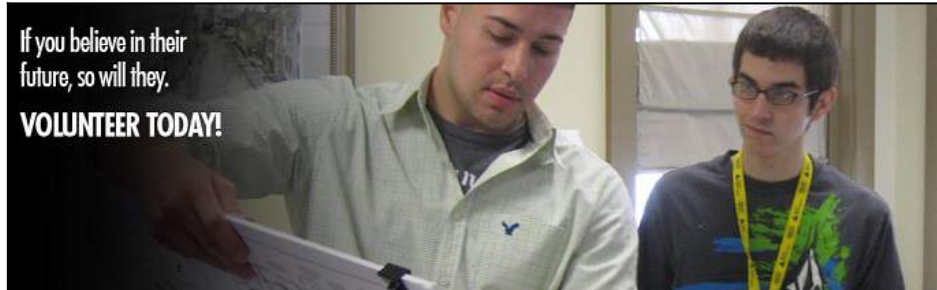


# Help New Bedford students find the path to success!
