Borrowers must be 18 years and older and can have up to 3 items checked out a time. All New Bedford Library locations have a variety of items to be checked out.

"We are really excited to be able to offer something new for families in our community and can't wait to see which items get checked out first," said Olivia Melo, Library Director. "This collection was made possible through the dedicated work of Youth Services Librarian Bethany Coito and Marissa Perez-Dormitzer, Waste Reduction Manager."
